Fulbright Visiting Scholar Program competition for the 2020-2021 academic year.

The Fulbright Visiting Scholar Program awards grants to foreign scholars to conduct postdoctoral research at U.S. universities for an academic year or term.

PRIORITY FIELDS OF STUDY ARE:

- Political Science, Economics, Social Science
- International Relations, Journalism and Law
- American Studies (History, Society & Culture of the United States, including Arts Management)
- Education Administration
- Environmental Studies and Public Health

YOU'RE ELIGIBLE IF YOU HAVE:

- Armenian citizenship and residency
- Evidence of employment in the Republic of Armenia
- A Ph.D.
- English proficiency
- Completed your online application
- Provided reference letters

Tips for the application process:

- Register for the online application system by creating a user name and a password.
- Follow the application's prompts.
- Save your data after completing each page.
- You do not have to complete the application in one sitting. You will be able to log off and return to your application later.
- All applicants will be able to send online requests for recommendation letters to their recommenders.
- Please submit your online application **ONLY** when all information is complete and the supplementary documents are obtained.
- Only online applications will be considered.

What happens next?

All applications, including references, undergo technical and academic reviews. Candidates who satisfy all requirements will be interviewed by the Embassy Fulbright Selection Committee. The Committee will submit the names of the selected finalists to the Fulbright Board of Foreign Scholarships in the U.S. for final approval. Selected grantees will be notified of final approval when their affiliations at U.S. universities are confirmed in June 2020 and funding is available.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

- <u>What are the selection criteria?</u> The following factors are considered: professional qualifications, research proposal (quality, feasibility), how the acquired knowledge will be used upon return, English language competence, need for the project to be undertaken in the United States, quality of references. Preference will be given to candidates with little or no previous experience in the United States.
- <u>What are the basic benefits included in the scholarship?</u> Round trip international airfare, monthly stipend, book allowance, and a settling-in allowance, and participation in Fulbright enrichment activities.
- <u>Can family members accompany me?</u> Yes, but you will be financially responsible for them.
- **Do I have to arrange university placement in the United States?** It is recommended that you submit a letter of invitation from a U.S. university in your application package. If you don't know where your project can be accomplished, the affiliation will be arranged by one of the Fulbright administering agencies.
- <u>How should I provide my references?</u> References should be provided online together with the application. A request for a reference letter is sent to the recommender through the online system and is received by the program coordinator at the U.S. Embassy. You will receive a notification when the recommendation letter is submitted.
- <u>How should I electronically sign the application?</u> *Please enter your name under "Electronic Signature."*
- <u>Am I required to provide supplemental forms?</u> No additional forms are necessary. No need for any printed documents to be brought to the Embassy.
- <u>The application form requires that I contact the Embassy before starting the</u> <u>online application. Is this requirement strict?</u> No, there it is not necessary to contact the Embassy to start the application.
