

Climate & Displacement: Building Euro-Arab bridges

Dates: 20.10.2023 – 28.10.2023

Place: Sharm El-Sheikh, Egypt

Description: This project is tailored for youth workers and socially active individuals. It aims to explore the complex relationship between climate change and increasing population displacement. Participants, representing both European and Arab perspectives, will explore the root causes of climate-induced migration, such as sea-level rise and extreme weather events. Through storytelling, policy analysis and solution-oriented workshops, the initiative aims to strengthen the role of youth workers in promoting understanding and building resilient communities. By emphasising collaboration, cultural exchange and empathy, the programme aims to forge a unified approach to the intertwined challenges of climate change and displacement.
